



Polish Culture Collections





Catalogue of cultures from 1972





The first catalog of microbiological resources of the Polish Cultures Collections was compiled with initiative of the Hirszfeld Institute of Immunology and Experimental Therapy of the Polish Academy of Sciences in 1972. The catalog was published in English, allowing for its international distribution. Many of presented strains are reference strains from important world collections such as: ATCC, CCM, CBS, IP or NCTC.

Eight institutions with collections of microorganisms entered the project of the common catalog:
