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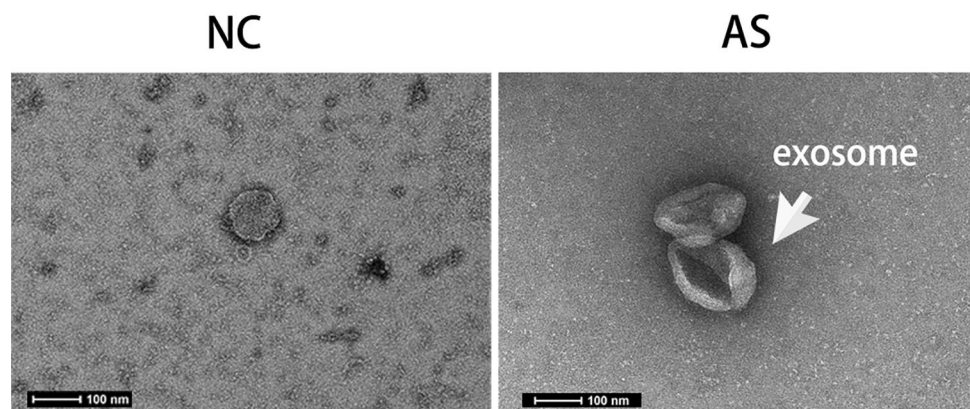

Fig. 1 Scanning electron microscopy of exosomes. Left: NC group. Right: AS group, the exosome was shown in white arrow

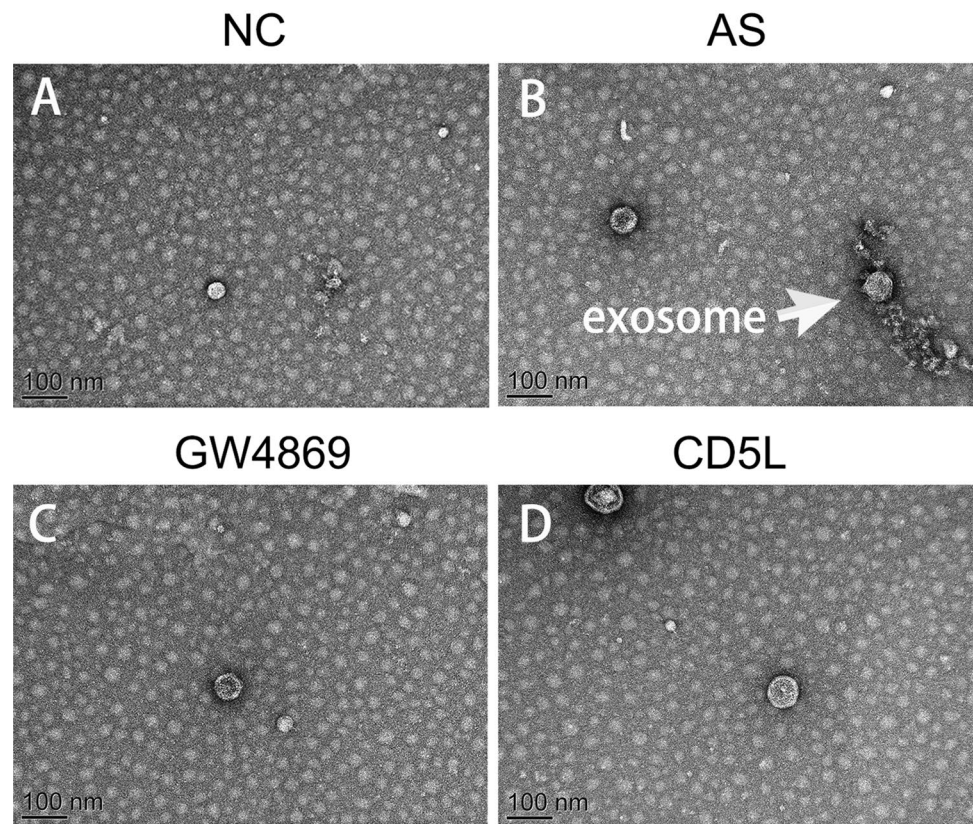
